Employment Profiles of Graduates

The candidates who successfully complete the Faculty of Medicine are also entitled to specialize in a field as a result of the Medical Specialty Examination (TUS).

Graduates who achieve sufficient scores in their desired field are eligible to receive specialized training in the following areas at universities or training and research hospitals: Emergency Medicine, Forensic Medicine, Family Medicine, Anatomy, Anesthesiology and Reanimation, Neurosurgery, Dermatology and Venereal Diseases, Pediatric Surgery, Child and Adolescent Psychiatry, Internal Medicine, Infectious Diseases and Clinical Microbiology, Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation, Physiology, General Surgery, Thoracic Surgery, Pulmonology, Ophthalmology, Public Health, Aviation and Space Medicine, Histology and Embryology, Obstetrics and Gynecology, Cardiology, Ear, Nose and Throat Diseases, Cardiovascular Surgery, Neurology, Nuclear Medicine, Orthopedics and Traumatology, Pediatrics, Plastic, Reconstructive and Aesthetic Surgery, Psychiatry, Radiation Oncology, Radiology, Sports Medicine, Underwater Medicine and Hyperbaric Medicine, Medical Biochemistry, Medical Pharmacology, Medical Genetics, Medical Microbiology, Medical Pathology, and Urology.

General Information About the Program

Yalova University Faculty of Medicine was established with the approval of our President, Mr. Recep Tayyip Erdoğan, and was published in the Official Gazette dated 06.02.2021, No. 31387. The Faculty of Medicine, implemented with the "Affiliation" model, which includes the use and cooperation of facilities belonging to the Ministry of Health with relevant university departments, aims to offer a contemporary, scientific, and state of the art educational program in every aspect.



The Faculty of Medicine, which develops solutions to address patients' health problems and restore them to health, provides basic and clinical medical knowledge during the first three years of its six-year education program. After that, students receive clinical training for two years, and in the final year, they enter the internship period. Students who successfully complete the final year are awarded the title of Medical Doctor.



Why Yalova University Faculty of Medicine?

Students who will receive their medical education at Yalova University Faculty of Medicine, located in one of the most important areas of the Marmara region, will have access to all the resources of science and modern medicine in the healthcare field. Our faculty, recognizing the importance of healthcare education even more during the pandemic days, decided to start educational activities without delay and accepted students in the 2021-2022 academic year.

According to the results of the 2021 Higher Education Institutions Examination, candidates who choose Yalova University Faculty of Medicine will complete the first three years of their education at the Faculty of Medicine of Uludağ University, one of the most established universities in the region.

Students who will continue their clinical internships and final year studies at Yalova University Faculty of Medicine will be able to take advantage of the facilities of the newly completed 400-bed state hospital in Yalova.
